


Join Our WORLD PRAYER TEAM

PRAY WITH US FOR THRU THE BIBLE PRODUCERS

and Listeners from around the world



- After years of prayer, planning, and hard work, *Thru the Bible*-Mongolian went on the air. Already people are responding to the Good News. Pray for continued fruit.
- Pray that God's Word will be heard in North Korea through AM radio transmitters—one of the only ways to skirt government attempts at blocking *Thru the Bible* and all other "foreign media" from the country.
- Thanks to your prayers, the broadcast is back on the air on FM stations inside Japan!




- Pray for godly witnesses in central European countries where Islamic strongholds dominate the faith scene, specifically in Bulgaria where Muslim missionaries outnumber Christian ministries.



- Dr. McGee first began teaching on the radio for just one day a week in 1941, the same year the United States entered World War II. In the early 1950's, a daily Bible-teaching program launched under the name of "High Noon Bible Class." And our five-year program—what Dr. McGee affectionately called "the Bible Bus"—pulled out of Pasadena, California, bound for roads unimagined in 1967.
- Pray that God will use all of our new and exciting ministry tools, technology, and partnerships to bring His Word to more people around the world.
 - Thank God for our ministry partnership with *Faith Comes by Hearing* that offers the audio and text versions of the Bible in more than 800 languages.
 - Pray for the development of *Thru the Bible* into several Canadian native languages.



- God is doing an astounding work in a region of the world that has been historically closed to the gospel. Pray for the light of God's Word to shine on the dominantly Muslim culture. Boldly ask God for salvation in the name of Jesus Christ to be proclaimed through the daily broadcast—available online, on television, and on the radio throughout the region.
- The first Kurdish *Thru the Bible* program went on the air this year in Kurdistan with a potential audience of 1.5 to 2.5 million listeners. Pray and celebrate that now both Kurdish and Arabic-speaking citizens of Kurdistan can hear the Word of God—each in their own heart language.
 - Each weeknight, *Thru the Bible*-Persian is part of a 90-minute primetime block of Christian broadcasts to Iran. Pray for the effectiveness of this powerful shortwave transmitter, a great source of communication from outside the country.



- Genocide, isolation, illiteracy, poverty, government corruption—the people of Southeast Asia have suffered horribly in recent generations. But now these relatively youthful populations are open to new ideas and ways of thinking. Intercede for the precious people of Southeast Asia; ask God to open their eyes to faith in Him and understanding of His Word.
- Through a fruitful partnership with FEBC, *Thru the Bible* is now heard and distributed in seven additional languages in Vietnam: Ede, Katu, Chrau, Jarai, Jeh, Yao, and Koho. Pray for the people who are hearing God's Word taught for the first time in Vietnam.
 - Ask God to bless the broadcasting of *Thru the Bible* in Myanmar. Pray that as Burmese listeners gain a deeper knowledge of the Bible, God will raise leaders for their churches.
 - Pray that God's Word will correct false perceptions about important biblical doctrines in the Philippines.



- Taking God's Word to Central Asia is possible only as God opens doors. Pray especially for God's protection over a million-watt transmitter that reaches into Muslim-dominant countries like Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, Kyrgyzstan, and Turkmenistan. We can be confident that wherever God's Word goes it accomplishes God's plan. Pray for a garden to grow in this spiritual desert.
- To be a Christian in central Asia is to entrust your life daily to God. Pray for the physical, emotional, and spiritual protection of every believer (less than 1% of this region's population).
 - Pray for online ministry possibilities, specifically in Russia.



- In generations past, great theologians came from Western Europe. Over time and several world wars, many Europeans have walked away from God. Grand churches and cathedrals sit empty. Pray for spiritual revival and a renewed passion for God's Word to sweep across these nations where God's name was once held high.
- A new outreach in the U.K. allows *Thru the Bible* to broadcast on a national Digital Audio Broadcasting (DAB) network covering most of the country. Pray for a new generation of Brits to be interested in knowing the Bible and Jesus Christ.
 - Pray for the many Arabic speakers who live in Europe to be drawn to sound Bible teaching heard on *Thru the Bible*. Pray they find peace with God and man through God's Son, Jesus Christ.



- Many Latin American countries have faced decades of internal violence and political instability, creating a culture of fear where one-third of the population already lives in poverty. Pray for peace and truth to reign in these countries that stretch from the southern border of the United States to the southern tip of South America.
- Pray for peace and reconciliation in Colombia. As many as 5 million Colombians have been forced from their homes due to ongoing violence between the government and drug cartels.
 - Pray for the Quiché broadcasts to reach the more than one million people who live in the central highlands of Guatemala and for expansion efforts to also reach those living in Peru, parts of Argentina, and Spain.
